ABSTRACT

Data collection and data analysis procedures within a decolonial stance are still matter of discussion. This seminar is the scenario to problematize researchers' assumptions in relation to how to proceed or adventured alternative ways of knowing and of digging out data, how to relate to participants, how to be part of the process, how to achieve coherence between theory, practice and intervention. It is our main interest that participants in the seminar consolidate data collection procedures and explore ways to implement the whole research.

SEMINAR DESCRIPTION

This seminar will have a main component: Students' oral presentations of their research process. Each session will be oriented to show students' plans and ways to proceed to achieve their work specific objectives. Students must show advances in each component of their research, exposing their difficulties, assumptions and decisions. Readings aloud, selected papers, among other activities can support students' ideas.

SEMINAR OBJECTIVES

General objective:

• To elaborate on the locus of enunciation in order to connect this with their research and ways to proceed.

Specific objectives

- To design oral presentation sessions to show advances of their work.
- To elaborate a rationale to back up data collection instruments and analysis

General thematic problem: Methods in dialogue (The North-South (re)visited) and the making up of a doctoral research proposal for final examination

Guiding question: How to achieve consistency and coherence between research components within a south stance?
