#### **ABSTRACT**

This seminar as part of the doctoral emphasis component seeks to help doctoral students to locate their own research within the contemporary Colombian scholarship around ELT Education. The seminar focus will be on the two doctoral emphases of the ELT Education major: ELT, identity, power and inequality and Second language teacher education.

#### **SEMINAR DESCRIPTION**

This seminar seeks to understand the epistemologies, the thematic units, methodologies and local knowledge of the Colombian ELT academic community. In the context of the Colombian bilingual policy and the new educational reforms that the Ministry of Education has promulgated for initial teacher education programs it seems paramount to study the Colombian ELT thought around issues that could possibly inform from a bottom-up perspective such policies. The idea lies in analysing from a critical and a decolonial perspective and a sociology of absences and emergences scholarship work produced at the local level.

#### **SEMINAR OBJECTIVES**

### **General objective:**

To comprehend the locally generated knowledge around ELT EDUCATION and decenter this in terms of epistemologies, thematic units, epistemologies, methodologies and contributions in the context of the two research emphases (ELT, identity, power and inequality and Second language teacher education).

## **Specific objectives**

- To problematize local scholarship around ELT EDUCATION from the perspective of the two research emphases.
- To locate one's own research proposal within the local scholarship.
